Parking at ASA14

Both conference venues are located within the city centre and parking is often oversubscribed. For this reason we would not recommend parking around either venue, but for those who wish to do so there are a number of options.

The University of Edinburgh provides a Scratchcard service that allows people to purchase a daily parking permit (£10 per day), which gives them access to various parking spaces around the University. Please bear in mind that your permit will need to be ordered in advance of your arrival into Edinburgh.

Edinburgh Council provides metered on-street parking around both venues. These spaces are in high demand and availability cannot be guaranteed (£2.50 per hour).

For those in possession of a disability parking badge, there are allocated disabled parking spaces around George Square and the badge simply needs to be displayed in the car to use them (for free). However, you will need to contact the University's Transport and Parking Office in advance with your vehicle registration details.
